(pink for girls, Black for boys)

Tap: Capezio Fluid or Roxy in Black

i(Carmel for Girls, Black for Boys)

MT2/3: Black t-strap character shoes

Acro: Barefoot (no socks or tights)

Hip Hop: Black hi-top coverse style



for styles other than Ballet:
any color leotard or fitted top (no words on it), leggings or shorts, tights optional

Boys:
t-shirt or tank (must be white for ballet) & dance pants or athletic shorts (must be black for ballet)



Ballet:
black leotard (any style)
& pink tights for girls
Skirts optional for Pointe



Hair must be up neatly & securely for all classes. Buns are required for Ballet classes.
