

# Dress Code

## Why do we have a dress code?

We have a dress code so that our learning environment remains safe and professional. It is part of our core values to teach students responsibility for themselves and respect for the art, so we expect our dress code to be followed consistently. Students may be asked to change or sit out if they do not have the proper shoes and attire.



## Attire

### Young Children's Program (age 1-7):

- Black or pink leotard and tights or black, white or grey t-shirt and bottoms
- Shoulder length or longer hair up in a braid, bun or ponytail

### Studio Program & ETP (ages 7+):

- Non-ballet classes may wear any color tank, crop top, leotard, leggings, shorts *and/or* tights as long as they are fitted (looser clothing allowed for hip hop classes only)
- Shoulder length or longer hair must be up in a braid, bun or ponytail
- For Ballet & Pointe classes, Black leotard & pink tights or Black leggings & White t-shirt, hair in a bun

**Tumble & Acro:** Barefoot (footless tights, no socks)

**Ballet 1-3:** Capezio 2037 in Light Pink or Black

**Tap 1-3:** Capezio CG17 or Capezio 960 in Black
